## COVID-19 contributions in time of need

During this time, many are still feeling the effects from COVID-19 and need support more than ever. In response, CHS Community Giving and the CHS Foundation have contributed more than \$450,000 to COVID-19 relief efforts.

The CHS Foundation [committed \\$225,000](#) to help future leaders continue their education and develop leadership skills. The funding will benefit 4-H programs student emergency funds at CHS Foundation university partners.

CHS Community Giving [contributed \\$125,000](#) to national and Twin Cities based social service agencies to provide critical community needs. CHS also matched more than \$100,000 in donations by more than 25 local cooperatives to support COVID-19 relief in rural communities.
